Rules and Regulations

- 1. This show is open to all North Carolina residents nine to eighteen years of age on January 1, 2018.
- 2. All polled breeds of cattle are eligible.
- 3. Heifers must be owned or cared for by the exhibitor for at least 60 days prior to the show.
- 4. Heifers must be halter broken. Exhibitors with unruly animals may be asked to leave the show ring.
- 5. Exhibitors may enter two animals in this show.
- 6. All animals must meet North Carolina health requirements.
- Heifers eligible for this show must be born between September 1, 2016 and April 30, 2018. Heifers will be broken into classes of similar ages. (The show committee reserves the right to rearrange classes.)
- 8. The Pitt County Fair and the Pitt County Youth Livestock Committee will not be responsible for any damages, death, injury, or loss of property incurred by or to any exhibitor or their animal.
- 9. This show is part of the Eastern Carolina Showmanship Circuit.
- 10. Entries are due by September 12. \$10 per head will be charged for all late entries.
- 11. Each pre-registered exhibitor will receive one armband plus two parent armbands at the gate. If there is more than one exhibitor per family, each additional exhibitor will get an armband. There will still only be two parent armbands per family.
- 12. Showmanship competition will be divided into three age categories: 9-11 years of age, 12-15 years of age, 15-18 years of age. The heifer shown in showmanship must be officially entered in the Pitt County Fair and can only be shown by the individual on the entry form.
