HOW TO JOIN

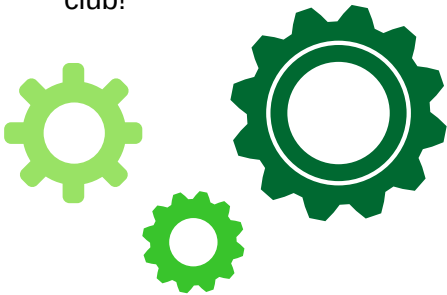

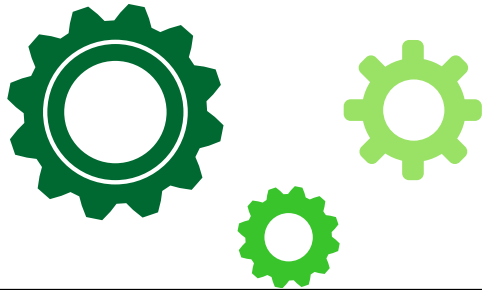
GET STARTED
